

Information on *ParentsOnline* Portal

Sterling Schools offers an online portal where parents can log in to see various information about their children enrolled in our school system. The available information includes Attendance, Grade Card, Progress Report, Schedule (for junior and senior high students), and Transcript.

Viewing the Progress Report is probably the most frequent activity in the online portal as parents are interested in how their children are doing in their classes, and the Progress Report provides the most up-to-date grade information reflecting what the teachers have entered in their grade books. This is probably most applicable to parents of 3rd-12th graders. Although parents of first and second graders are also welcome to check on their children's grades, there are likely fewer individual grades to see because of more group activities at those levels. Furthermore, there are no kindergarten grades to view.

If you have had access to the ParentsOnline portal in the past, your credentials for logging in should be the same as before. If your child is not listed on your portal, if you have forgotten your username or password, or if you have trouble accessing the information you want, please contact me using my contact details listed at the end of this note.

The information you provide will be used to start setting up your account, at which point you should receive an email with a link to click to finish that process.
