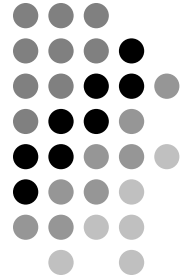
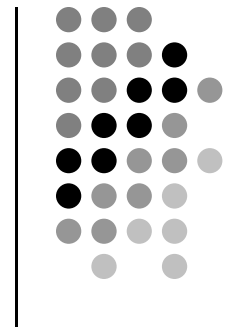


HOW TO: Take Good Photos

GOOD PHOTO COMPOSITION

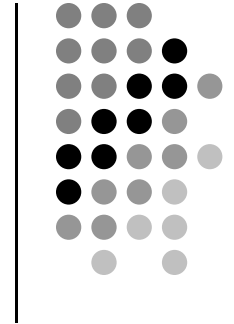


- Directs and holds attention
- Conveys only one idea
- Pleases the eye aesthetically
- Leads viewer to:
 - Main idea
 - Mood or feeling
 - Photographer's viewpoint



ONE MAIN SUBJECT

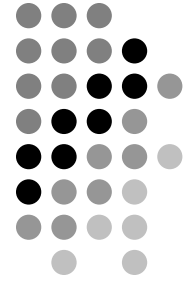
Can be complemented

picture



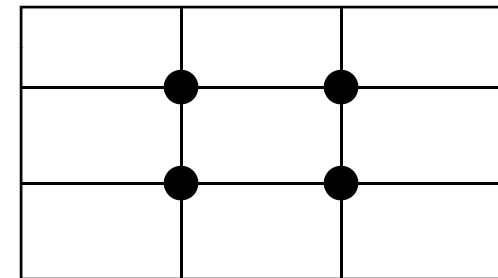
AVOID BULLS-EYE SYNDROME

Can center if:

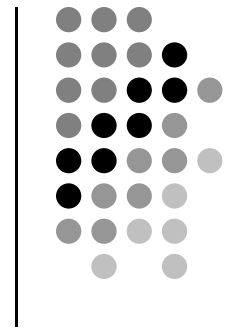
- Single person in front of plain background

- Piece of art



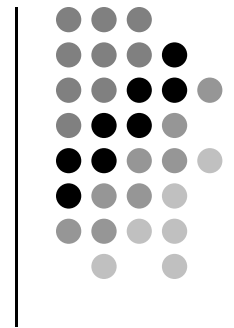
TIC-TAC-TOE RULE OF THIRDS



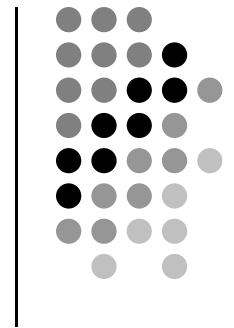
Focal point

of grid



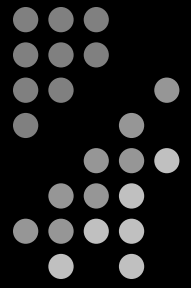
**HORIZON IS
